

St Joseph's Primary School Warragul School Uniform Policy

Purpose:

At St Joseph's Primary School, we have a standard of dress of which the members of our school community can be justifiably proud. Our uniform is neat, attractive, practical and economical. Wearing the uniform adds to the feeling of belonging and builds school spirit for students.

Aims:

To promote equality and identification amongst all students, and a sense of pride in our school. To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.

Implementation:

- The school's uniform dress code applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions. (This may be waived on some occasions.)
- The summer uniform will be worn during Terms 1 and 4.
- The winter uniform will be worn during Terms 2 and 3.
- It is expected that all students are in the Winter uniform by 1st of May and the Summer uniform by 1st of November.
- Sports uniform is to be worn only on sports day each week and for sporting events or excursions.
- Year 6 students may wear their Year 6 polo top on sports days and one other designated day, determined by the school
- St Joseph's school bag is a compulsory school uniform item.
- Regular washing of the school uniform and cleaning of school shoes is expected.

Students can wear a plain bottle green raincoat for wet weather protection in transition to and from school and on the yard.

Footwear

Footwear should be appropriate for school and the activities timetabled on that day. Socks or tights are to be worn at all times. Black school shoes must be completely black, no labels or white/coloured sections.

Hair and Headwear

School hats with the school logo are compulsory during terms 1 and 4. Caps are not permitted. Hats are not to be worn at assembly or inside the classrooms. Below shoulder length hair needs to be tied back neatly with neutral coloured or bottle green hair ties. Extreme hair colours and/or extreme hairstyles (eg: spikes, Mohawks) are not permitted.

Makeup and Jewellery

Nail polish and makeup are not permitted on school days. Stud earrings or sleepers can be worn in the ears and watches are the only acceptable jewellery. In line with our ICT User Agreement, smartwatches, that are able to act like a phone, must be handed into the classroom teacher each morning.

Policy review:

This policy was endorsed by our school leadership team and School Advisory Board in 2024 and will be reviewed in March 2026.
